Established in 2017 by Chairman & Secretary with 60 seats (increased to 100 in 2018), VPC launched its Pharm.D program in 2022. All courses 2-year D.Pharm, 4-year B.Pharm, and 6-year Pharm.D (currently in 3rd year) are affiliated to The TN Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai, and approved by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi. The library, a cornerstone of VPCW, receives top priority for periodic upgrades (₹6.20 Lakh allocation) and plays a vital role in academic excellence. It houses 1,131 titles, 6,329 volumes, subscriptions to 15 national and 17 international journals (total 32), 150 back volumes across 53 titles, 388 e-journals, and 10 magazines. Equipped with 10 internet-enabled computers, it provides access to 387 DELNET-listed e-journals and additional e-resources, supporting robust learning claims.
