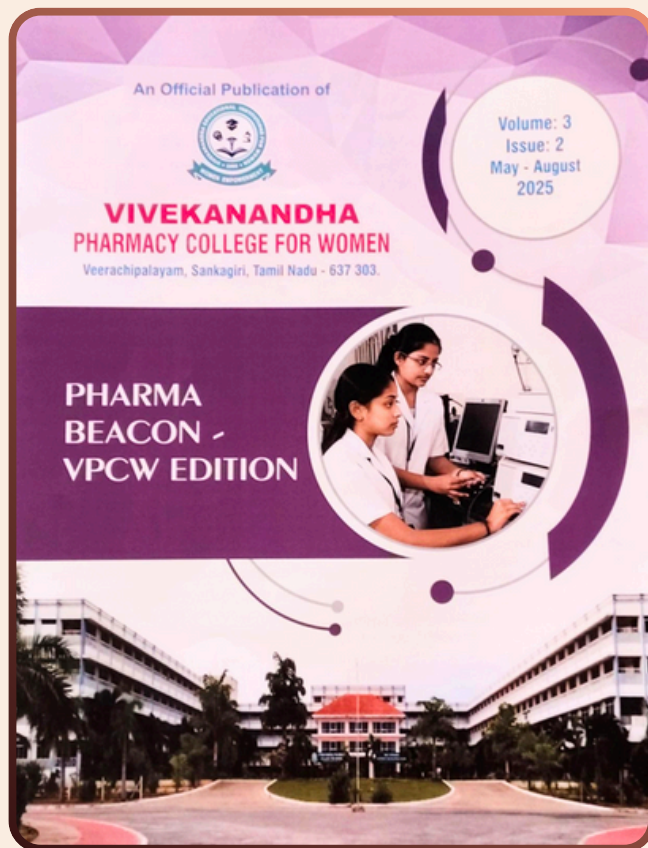

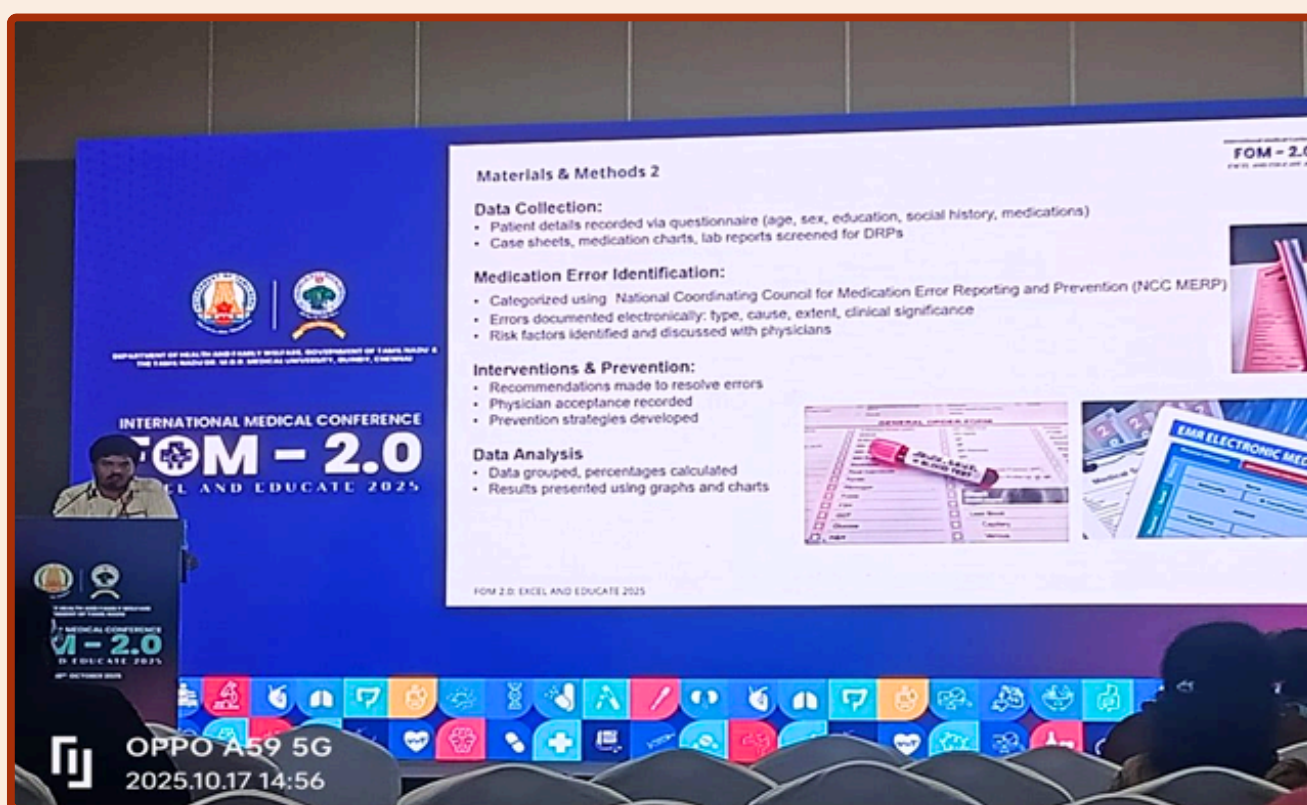

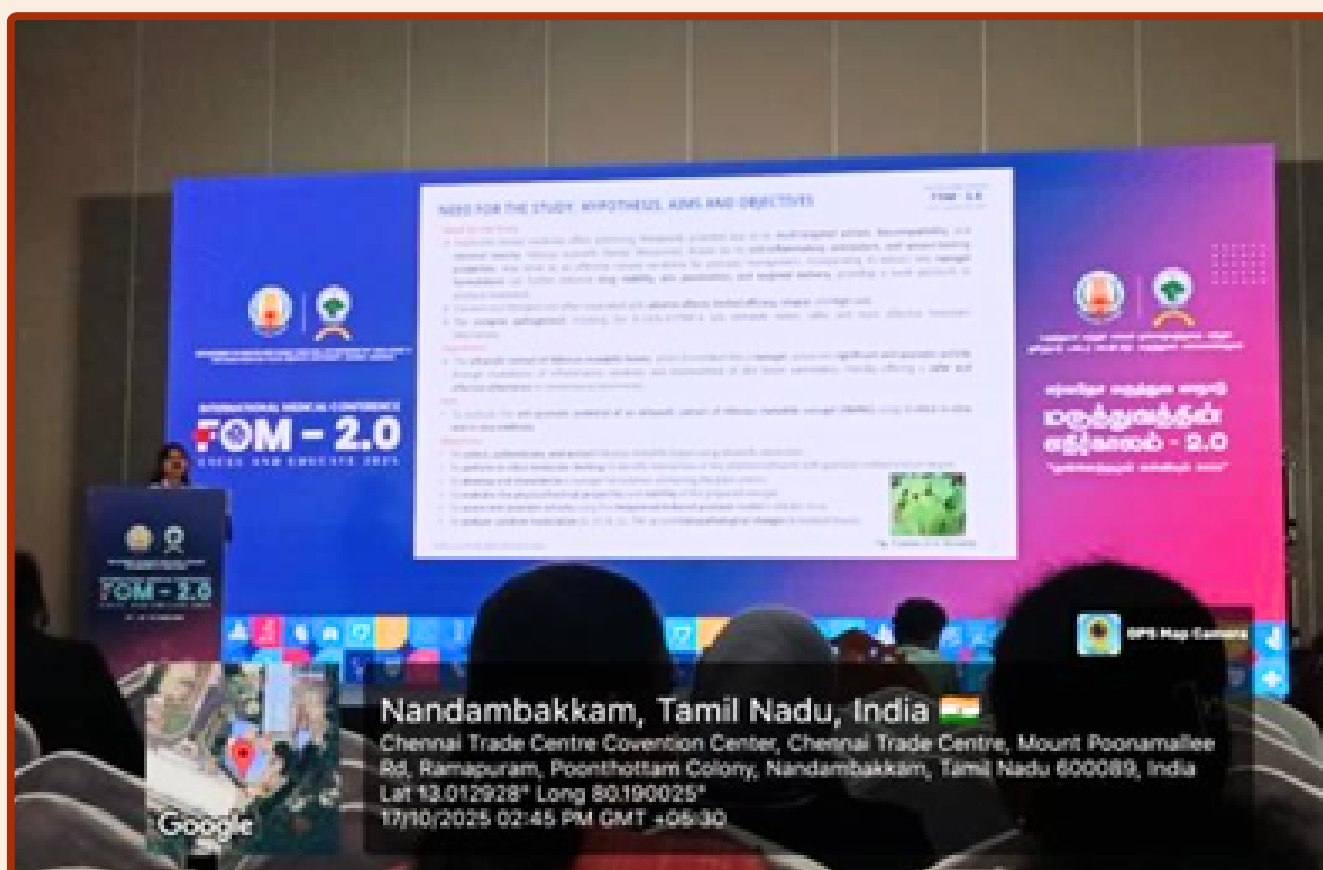
R – RESEARCH / RESPONSIBILITY

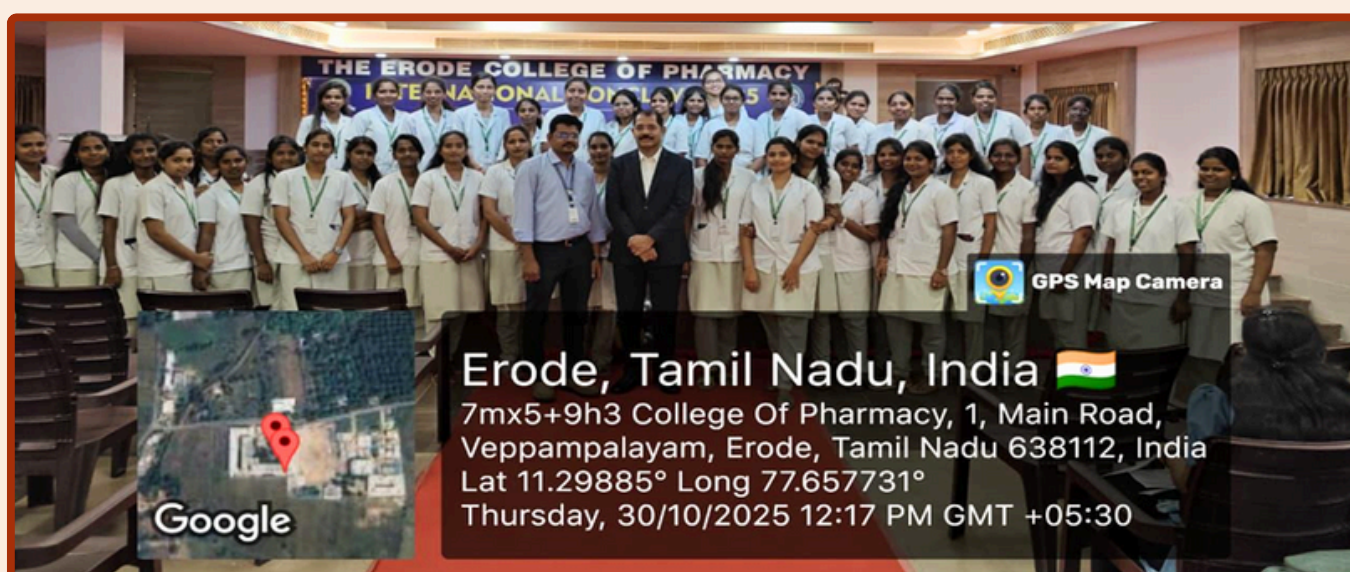

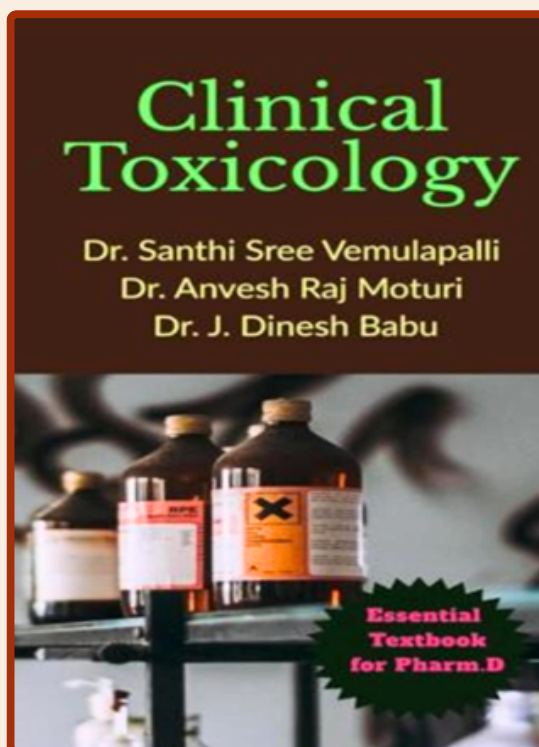
